



DRESS STANDARDS

Footwear: Bare feet, dirty footwear, heavy footwear (e.g. work boots), gumboots or socks in lieu of are not permitted at any time.

Jandals cannot be worn during special events or functions, or on Fridays or Saturdays after 7pm. (If applicable, please leave the premises by the deadlines given.)

Clothing: This standard relates to *outer garments visible to others*.

No torn or dirty clothing

No clothing with obscene or offensive logos or print detail

No singlets (i.e. a garment normally designed to be worn under other clothing)

Headgear:

Members or visitors may not wear headgear at any time unless pre-approved by the club for selected members/visitors or special functions/events.

Exceptions:

Armed Forces personnel in uniform on ceremonial occasions when full uniform is required to be worn indoors.

Lady's hats when worn as part of a formal outfit.

Hats or headgear worn for religious or medical reasons.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Members must carry their membership card at all times whilst on the premises, and produce same if requested by a Manager, Committee member or door person.

Visitors (i.e. a member of an affiliated Club)

Must sign the visitor's register at the bar and produce a current membership card if requested. Any person becoming a regular or frequent Visitor will be asked to transfer to or become a member of this Association. Visitors may also complete a one month "Provisional Membership" form to enable trial membership.

Guests (i.e. a non member invited and accompanied by a Member or Visitor)

Must be signed in by the member or visitor.

Must remain in the company of the member or visitor.

Must leave the premises before or at the same time as the host member or visitor.

Must be made aware of and comply with the Dress Regulations and Code of Conduct.

Must not become a regular or frequent guest. (unless a Provisional Member - see above)

Children

Under the age of 18 years must be in the company of and under close supervision of a parent or legal guardian.

Under the age of 18 years are not permitted in the Gaming Room.

Under the age of 14 years are not permitted unless closely supervised in pool table area, near the bar, nor be to be allowed to roam unattended in the club rooms or car park.

Off Limits Areas.

Unless specifically invited, no person is permitted to enter the following areas:

Bar and Bar Areas, Offices, Kitchen, Storerooms, Committee room.

Behaviour.

The Club reserves the right to deny entry to any person, whether a member or not.

If, in the opinion of the Duty Manager, you are considered intoxicated, you will be denied further service of alcohol and may be instructed to leave the premises.

You will be instructed to leave the premises should you purchase alcohol for a person already denied further service of alcohol.

Foul, abusive or derogatory language or comment is not acceptable in the premises.

Threatening behaviour is not acceptable in the premises.

Wilfull or negligent damage to club property of any form is not acceptable.

You are required to vacate the premises promptly at closing time.

Breaches of Rules

Breach of any of the above rules can result in suspension of Club privileges, cancellation of membership or legal removal from the Club Premises.

The Club reserves the right to decide on what grounds or basis these rules will be enforced.

These rules are displayed the entrance Foyer to the Club.
